Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been made for quashing of F.I.R. No.109 dated 12.09.2016 under Sections 295-A, 341 and 323 of the Indian Penal Code pertaining to Police Station Laddowal, District Ludhiana, on the basis of compromise dated 30.12.2016 (Annexure-P2).

On presentation of the petition, the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court/ Illaqa Magistrate to get their statements recorded for compromise with a direction to the Magistrate to furnish report alongwith the recorded statements qua veracity of the compromise, if any, between the parties.

Judge, Ludhiana vide letter No.1620/EC dated 17.06.2017 has been received.

According to the report of Judicial Magistrate, Ludhiana, the compromise between the parties is genuine and without any threat, coercion and undue influence.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, F.I.R. No.109 dated 12.09.2016 under Sections 295-A, 341 and 323 I.P.C. pertaining to Police Station Laddowal, District Ludhiana, is hereby quashed.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
