Through this petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, prayer has been made for quashing F.I.R. No.67 dated 02.05.2016 registered under Sections 307, 323, 324, 506, 379 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Daba, District Ludhiana, on the basis of compromise dated 11.05.2016 (Annexure-P2).

On presentation of this petition, vide order dated 23.05.2016 passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court, the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court within a period of 15 days, for recording their statements qua compromise with a direction to the trial Court to furnish a report regarding veracity thereof, if any, between the parties.

Consequently, the parties had appeared before the Judicial

statements. Report from the concerned Magistrate has been received vide letter No.788 dated 11.08.2016 duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Ludhiana vide letter No.617/EC dated 11.08.2016.

According to the report of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ludhiana, the compromise between the parties is voluntary and without any coercion from any end.

Perusal of order dated 01.08.2017 shows that the State counsel informed the Court that offence under Section 307 IPC has since been deleted and offence under Section 325 IPC has been added.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, the present petition is accepted and the aforesaid F.I.R. No.67 is quashed qua the petitioner, subject to depositing costs of ₹10,000/- by the petitioner with the Punjab Legal Services Authority, Chandigarh within one week, failing which this petition shall be deemed to be dismissed.
