Pursuant to the order dated 27.01.2017, learned counsel seeks to place on record a copy of the order dated 14.09.2016 passed in CRM-M-29029 of 2016, granting bail to one of the co-accused of the petitioner, who is stated to be Charanjeet @ Mandeep Kaur, who it is alleged had taken the decoy customer to the clinic, allegedly for the purpose of a gender determination test.

Application is allowed as prayed for.

The copy of the order dated 14.09.2016 is taken on record as Annexure P-2.

CRM-M-1695 of 2017

It is stated that the allegation against the petitioner is to the effect that he was in telephonic conversation with the aforesaid Charanjeet @ Mandeep Kaur at the relevant time.

Learned State counsel submits that the petitioner was one of the persons who was allegedly bringing customers to the clinic for the purpose of sex determination tests.

However, on query, he admits that even the aforesaid Mandeep Kaur is also accused of being such a person.

In view of the fact that the aforesaid Mandeep Kaur was also admitted to bail after more than two months of custody and the petitioner is not shown to be differently placed from her and he is also stated to be in custody since 16.12.2016, without commenting upon the merits of the case, this petition is allowed.

He would be released on bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court, subject to his continuing to appear before that Court as and when summoned, and his continuing to comply with any other conditions as would be laid down by the trial Court.
