Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.17 dated 29.3.2017 under Sections 324, 323, 452, 34 IPC and Section 326 IPC (added later on), registered at Police Station Qila Lal Singh Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that pursuant to order dated 31.5.2017 of this Court, the petitioners have joined investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jitender Singh, does not dispute the aforesaid fact and submits that the custody of the petitioners is no more required.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Considering the fact that the petitioners have joined investigation and their custody is no more required, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 31.5.2017 is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall join the investigation as and when directed by the investigating agency and shall abide by the terms and conditions laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
