This is the petition praying for issuance of appropriate and suitable directions to the respondent No.3 to take appropriate and suitable legal action and proper inquiry against the Respondent No.4 and 5 upon the Representation dated 16.11.2015 (Annexure P-1).

Reply has been filed by way of an affidavit of Rajesh Kumar HPS Assistant Commissioner of Police Kalka on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. It has been stated in the reply that during enquiry, from the statement of employees, it was found that the petitioner-Kanwaljit Kaur was an official, posted at Pinjore branch of HDFC Bank up to 10.01.2014. She was transferred on administrative ground to Panchkula branch . Thereafter, she made no direct or indirect reference about any sexual harassment during the discussion with Ms. Bharti Kapoor-Member of the committee against Bharat Chugh and Amandeep Singh. There is no recommendation from the Internal Committee or the local Committee

for registration of criminal case. After resignation, the petitioner made a complaint to the internal Complaints Committee of the Bank on 19.05.2014 and the complaint was found to be time barred. No appeal against this decision has been filed by the petitioner. After making the necessary enquiry, no cognizable offence was found to be made out.

No further directions are required to be issued in this petition.

Disposed of accordingly.
