This is a petition under Section 482 Cr. P.C. seeking quashing of the impugned order dated 26.4.2017 (Annexure P-1) passed by Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Pathankot vide which the trial Court has dismissed the application filed under Section 320 (2) Cr. P.C. for compounding of the offence.

As per the version given in the FIR, petitioner-accused has collected ₹ 1,50,000/- from one Shiv Kumar who is stated to have compromised the matter with the petitioner-accused and has made this application before the trial Court for compounding of the same.

Since, the petition is not supported by any affidavit or any evidence to show that the petitioner has compounded the offence with the other nine aggrieved persons from whom he has collected money, no ground is made out to interfere in the order passed by learned trial Court on 26.4.2017.

Dismissed.
