FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

Report dated 14.02.2017 of learned Additional Sessions Judge, Faridkot has been received whereby after recording statements of complainant Sandeep Kansal alias Deepu and Usha Kansal as well as the accused persons namely Shiv Kumar @ Shivji, Manish Kumar @ Monu, Krishan Kumar @ Kapten and Vicky Kumar @ Vicky, the Court has shown its satisfaction that the compromise Ex.P1 has been arrived at voluntarily, out of free will of the parties, without any undue influence, coercion or pressure.

Heard.

In the light of the satisfaction shown by the Court, the fact that parties belong to the same very area and the offences for which the accused have been hauled up are not of serious nature, together with the

fact that compromise will go a long way in ironing out differences for betterment of future life of the parties and in view of the law laid down in **‘Gian Singh v. State of Punjab and another’ 2012(4) RCR (Criminal) 543** and **‘Kulwinder Singh and others v. State of Punjab and another’ 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052**, the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No.31 dated 16.04.2016 registered at Police Station Jaito, District Faridkot under Sections 365, 364-A, 120-B IPC and all consequences arising out of the said FIR qua the petitioners are quashed.

The petition stands allowed in those terms.
