It is not in dispute that the petitioner was released on bail
by the order made by this Court in CRM-M-38715 of 2016, on
02.12.2016. The petitioner failed to appear before the trial Court on the
appointed date, namely 09.05.2017. The reason given by the petitioner
that the wrong date was noted. Learned counsel for the petitioner, on
instructions, states that the petitioner undertakes not to make any
default in appearance hereinafter before the trial Court in the trial and
therefore, in my opinion, he should be given a chance to remain at
liberty for facing trial.

Accepting the undertaking given by the petitioner, this

petition is disposed of. The order cancelling bail and issuance of non-bailable warrants (Annexure P-4) is quashed and set aside on the undertaking given by the petitioner that he would not make any default in appearance before the trial Court. Upon the petitioner committing any default, the trial Court would be at liberty to take him in custody.
