Learned counsel for the petitioner has produced some receipts showing that some amount has been paid.

On the other hand, learned counsel respondent no.5 bank has produced statement showing that Rs.2,95,000/- are still over due as amount of EMI. Total loan amount is around Rs.twenty lakhs. Learned counsel for respondent No.5 bank has undertaken that the bank will not use coercive means to re-possess the truck bearing registration no.PB-11-BY-2879 and will adopt due process of law.

In the circumstances, the present petition is disposed of with directions to respondent no.5 -bank that if the bank wants to re-possess the aforesaid truck on account of default of loan installments, the bank will adopt due process of law.
