I have heard learned counsel for the parties. Since no order has been passed by the competent authority in the Department of Education of the manner in which the suspension period is to be treated, and that the plaintiff approached the trial court directly then the matter would have to be remitted to the competent authority in the Department of Education to pass a specific order in the manner in which the suspension period is to be treated.

In view of the above, this appeal is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority in the Education Department that in case the plaintiff/appellant makes a representation within a period of one month from today, the same will be decided within three months thereafter and the decree of the courts below is accordingly modified to accommodate this order.
