ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioners are seeking quashing of FIR No.116 dated 02.05.2015 under Sections 295-A/325 IPC registered at Police Station Sultanwind, District Amritsar, on the basis of compromise dated 11.04.2017 arrived at between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the FIR is an outcome of a misunderstanding between the parties which has now been resolved and the matter has been compromised.

A co-ordinate Bench of this Court, by the order dated 16.05.2017 had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court for recording their statements with regard to the veracity of compromise. The Judicial Magistrate Ist Class,

Jalandhar, has sent her report dated 18.07.2017, wherein it is stated that in pursuance to the order of this Court, statements of the parties were recorded. As per the statements, compromise has been effected without any fear or undue influence.

The FIR is an outcome of a misunderstanding between the parties which has now been resolved and the matter has been compromised.

In view of the law laid down in "**Narinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab**" 2014 (6) SCC 466, no useful purpose will be served by continuing the criminal proceedings. Therefore, the petition is allowed and FIR No.116 dated 02.05.2015 under Sections 295-A/325 IPC registered at Police Station Sultanwind, District Amritsar and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the petitioners only.
