Karam Singh @ Karma Singh has filed the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C praying for issuance of directions to the official respondents for taking appropriate action on a complaint dated 28.4.2017 (Annexure P-5).

Counsel for the petitioner has been heard.

Perusal of the complaint dated 28.4.2017 (Annexure P-5) would reveal that there are allegations levelled against Dharamjit Singh son of Kashmir Singh as regards having kidnapped the daughter of the petitioner namely Lakhwinder Kaur. It is alleged that Dharamjit Singh has forged the date of birth of Lakhwinder Kaur in the Aadhar Card as 4.1.1998, whereas her actual date of birth is 1.1.2003. In the complaint it has also been asserted that such forged Aadhar Card has been used and relied upon while filing a protection petition in this Court i.e. CRM No. M-14473 of 2017.

The uncontroverted factual position is that daughter of the petitioner namely Lakhwinder Kaur and Dharamjit Singh had jointly filed CRM No. M-14473 of 2017 and which had been disposed of by this Court

vide order dated 27.4.2017 in the following terms:-

“Heard.

Pleadings on record have been perused.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 i.e. SHO, Police Station Bhindi Saidan, that in case any representation is filed seeking protection of life and liberty, the contents thereof be duly verified and if necessary, requisite steps be taken, strictly in accordance with law for grant of protection of life and liberty to the petitioners. It is clarified that this order shall not be treated as a stamp of this Court for marriage of the parties.

Petition stands disposed of.”

Without going into the merits of the case the instant petition is disposed of with a direction to the S.H.O, Police Station, Bhindi Saidan/respondent no.3 to even examine the complaint dated 28.4.2017 (Annexure P-5) in the light of the fact that he has already been directed to look into the matter in pursuance to the protection petition having been filed by Lakhwinder Kaur and Dharamjit Singh.

Respondent no.3 would be obligated to examine the complainant dated 28.4.2017 (Annexure P-5) and to thereafter proceed in the matter as deemed fit and as warranted strictly in accordance with law.

Disposed of.
