Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the life and liberty of the petitioner has been threatened by respondents no.4 to 13, on account of the fact that her son married the grand-daughter of respondent no.7 and thereafter approached this Court by filing CRM-M-20683 of 2016, seeking protection of life and liberty.

That petition was disposed of on 15.09.2016 as having been rendered infructuous, on a statement made by counsel appearing for the petitioners in that case, i.e. the son and daughter-in-law of the present petitioner.

He reiterates that though at that time a statement had been made to the effect that there was no danger to the lives and liberty of the petitioners in that petition, but thereafter, respondents no.4 to 13 are threatening the petitioner on account of the marriage of her son with the grand-daughter of respondent no.7.

He further submits that in fact an FIR has been registered at Police Station Punhana, District Mewat, against the aforesaid respondents at the instance of the petitioner on 13.04.2017, for the alleged commission of

offences punishable under Sections 148, 149, 323, 452 and 506 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that at this stage, he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondents no.2 and 3, to take action as per law and ensure that the life and liberty of the petitioner and her family member is duly protected.

Consequently, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents no.2 and 3, i.e. the Superintendent of Police, Nuh, District Nuh, and Station House Officer, Police Station Punhana, District Nuh, to immediately look into the matter and to take action as per law and also ensure that the lives and liberty of the petitioner and her family member are duly protected within the four corners of law.
