The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of directions to official respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners. Further directions are to direct respondent No.4 not to harass the petitioners and at the instance of respondents No.5 to 7.

The averments made in the instant petition are utterly vague.

Petitioners No.2 and 3 had earlier approached this Court by filing CRM-M-13598 of 2017 and which has been disposed of by this Court in the light of order dated 21.04.2017 and in the following terms:-

*“Heard.*

*Pleadings on record have been  
perused.*

*The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 i.e. Station House Officer, Police Station, Balachaur, District S.B.S. Nagar, that in case any representation is filed seeking protection of life and liberty, the contents thereof be duly verified and if necessary, requisite steps be taken, strictly in accordance with law for grant of protection of life and liberty to the petitioners. It is clarified that this order shall not be treated as a stamp of this Court for marriage of the parties.*

*Petition stands disposed of.”*

No further directions are required to be passed.

At this stage, counsel prays for withdrawal of the instant petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
