By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought pre-arrest bail in FIR No.116 dated 26.08.2014, registered under Section 21 of NDPS Act, at Police Station Sadar Hoshiarpur, Distt. Hoshiarpur.

Contentends that the petitioner had been admitted to bail by the trial Court. During the subsistence of the bail, the petitioner was falsely implicated in another FIR. The petitioner had informed his counsel to bring it to the notice of the Court concerned. However, this fact could not be communicated to the Court which has resulted into passing of order dated 09.12.2015, whereby the non-bailable warrants have been issued against the petitioner.

Notice of motion.

At this stage, Mr. Luvinder Sofat, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. A complete set of paperbook has been handed over to the learned State counsel, in the Court.

Heard.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is disposed of and the petitioner is directed to appear before the trial Court, within a week from today, and furnish bail bonds/surety bonds. In the event of his doing so, he shall be admitted to bail by the trial Court, to its satisfaction.
