ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.45 dated 28.09.2016, under Sections 323, 324, 341, 506, 148, 149 IPC and Section 326 IPC added later on, registered at Police Station City Banga, District Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been attributed two simple injuries on the non-vital parts of the body of the complainant-Gurjinder Singh.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Jaswinder Singh, states that in terms of the previous order of this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

The injuries attributed to the petitioner are simple in nature and are stated to be on non vital parts of the body of the complainant.

In view of the above, the order dated 31.05.2017 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
