Petitioner-Ajay Kumar has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.199 dated 20.07.2015, registered at Police Station Line Paar Bahadurgarh, District Jhajjar, under Sections 21 and 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.

Notice of motion was issued in this case. Learned State counsel has put in appearance on behalf of respondent-State and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that as per the prosecution version, the present petition has been named by co-accused from whom recovery of 52 bottles of Corex (100 ml. each) and 160 bottles of Rexcof (100 ml. each) was effected.

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Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and in view of the fact that the petitioner has been nominated in the present FIR on the disclosure statement of co-accused, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
