By this common order, above said all four petitions would be
disposed of.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioners fairly state that the challan has not yet been filed as the investigation has been retaken by the higher officer and is underway.

To find out, prima-facie case, at this stage, in all these petitions for regular bail as well as anticipatory bail, I have perused the statement of the complainant and find that all the petitioners have been named by the complainant himself on the same day after the lodgment of the complaint with the police station concerned. It is not true to say that accused persons were named after some period. As a matter of fact, the statement shows that they have been named in the same statement immediately after the complaint is lodged. In that view of the matter, since the investigation is still pending, I am not inclined to grant bail for the present.

Hence, all these petitions stand dismissed for the present. Liberty is reserved in favour of all the petitioners to apply for bail after the investigation is completed. Learned State counsel is directed to inform the investigating officer to complete the investigation in any case within a period of one and a half month from today and take necessary steps, accordingly.
