Petitioner-Satish Parmar has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.865 dated 22.11.2015, registered at Police Station City Sirsa, under Section 18 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.

Notice of motion was issued in this case. Learned State counsel put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that earlier the petitioner was on regular bail and appearing before the Court. However, he absented from the court proceedings on 04.01.2017.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that absence was not intentional.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find that trial of the case will take a long time and no useful purpose will be served by sending the petitioner to custody. Therefore, finding merit in the present petition, the same is allowed. The petitioner is directed to surrender before the trial Court within 10 days from today. On doing so, he shall be released on bail by learned trial Court to its satisfaction. If the petitioner fails to appear before the trial Court within the aforesaid stipulated period, the instant petition shall be treated as dismissed.
