Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in FIR No.28 dated 28.02.2017, under Sections 21/22/61/85 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substance Act, 1985 read with Sections 25/54/59 of Arms Act, 1959 and Sections 341/379 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short 'IPC') (Section 379 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Ajnala, District Amritsar Rural.

I have perused the FIR and seen the impugned order passed by the learned trial Court. Petitioner was arrested on the disclosure statement of the co-accused. There are serious allegations against the petitioner of holding illegal weapons. In that view of the matter, relief of grant of regular bail to the petitioner cannot be granted.

Petition stands dismissed.
