This is a petition under Section 439(2) read with Section 482 Cr.P.C for cancellation of anticipatory bail granted to respondent No.2 by this Court in FIR No.08 dated 01.02.2016 registered under Sections 406 and 498-A IPC at Police Station Women, District Ludhiana .

The present petition was filed with the allegations that the respondent No.2 has violated the terms and conditions of the compromise. However, after the filing of the present petition, in terms of the compromise, the parties have filed petition under Section 13-B of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955. So, the limited purpose of filing the present petition now stands achieved.

Learned State counsel, on instructions states that the State has not received any complaint moved by the petitioner against

respondent No.2, therefore, no case for cancellation of bail in the changed circumstances is made out.

Consequently, the petition is dismissed.
