This petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.492 dated 17.08.2016, under Sections 306/34 IPC, registered at Police Station, Samalkha, District Panipat.

The petitioner (father-in-law of deceased) is in custody since 17.08.2016. Marriage of deceased-Seema was solemnized with son of the petitioner about 12 years back. After marriage, they were residing separately from the petitioner and his wife.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, has informed that after presentation of challan, charges have been framed on 01.02.2017 and 11 prosecution witnesses are to be examined before the trial Court.

Heard.

Keeping in view the period of incarceration of the petitioner and the fact that trial may take some time for its conclusion, this Court feels that

there is no need to detain the petitioner any longer. Accordingly, this

petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be enlarged on regular bail on furnishing of bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate/Chief Judicial Magistrate, Panipat.
