The petitioners were summoned in exercise of powers under Section 319 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 as additional accused persons.

Mr. Sumeet Puri, Advocate appears for the complainant and objects the petition for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners and submitted that the petitioners should not be released on anticipatory bail.

I do not agree with the same. I have perused the record and inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Hence, in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on anticipatory bail on their furnishing bail bonds amounting to ₹10,000/- with one surety of like amount, subject to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned who may impose such conditions as deem fit and proper.

Petition stands disposed of, accordingly.
