Petitioner is the author of grievous injury on the person of Ranjeet Kaur. First injury was inflicted with *gandasi* blow on the forehead of Ranjeet Kaur and the same was found to be sharp simple falling under Section 324 IPC. The second blow was attributed with reverse side of the *gandasi* which ultimately landed on the left elbow of Ranjeet Kaur. This injury was found to be grievous in nature. The third injury was inflicted on the person of Kamalpreet Kaur on her right shoulder with reverse side of the *gandasi* and the said injury was found to be simple in nature.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Balbir

Singh states that petitioner is the author of grievous injuries and the weapon of offence is yet to be recovered.

On 16.05.2017, notice of motion was issued by this Court. Today mother-in-law Ranjeet Kaur along with wife Kamalpreet Kaur and brother-in-law Harjinder Singh of the petitioner are present. Kamalpreet Kaur is still apprehensive in respect of conduct of the petitioner and is not inclined to go with him.

In view of above, no case is made out to grant concession of anticipatory bail. Petition stands dismissed.
