The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.202 dated 22.04.2017 under Sections 420/465/467/468/471/120-B IPC registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Amritsar City, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioners, *inter-alia*, contends that the petitioners are the witnesses of General Power of Attorney dated 14.09.2004 in which the identity of the executants is not in dispute.

A co-ordinate Bench of this Court by the order dated 16.05.2017, had directed the petitioners to join investigation and in the event of arrest, they were ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Amarpal Singh, states that in pursuance to the order dated 16.05.2017, the petitioners have joined investigation and are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above and without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, the order dated 16.05.2017, granting ad-interim bail to the petitioners, is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
