Learned State Counsel on instructions from H.C. Surender Kumar, Police Station City Kaithal submits that private respondents No.4 to 6 have made statements before the police that they do not have any objection to the marriage of the present petitioners. Similarly petitioners too have made statements that no more threat to their lives and personal liberty exists, which fact too is not controverted by the counsel for the petitioners.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioners on instructions from his clients wishes to withdraw the present petition.

Allowed to do so.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

However, in case any instance of threat is brought to the notice of the Police by the petitioners they will act into it expeditiously and ensure due protection of life and personal liberty to them, in accordance with law.
