Petitioner seeks quashing of FIR No.105 dated 21.05.2016, under Sections 406, 498-A of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short 'IPC'), registered at Police Station Gobindgarh Mandi, District Fatehgarh Sahib, on the basis of compromise.

Learned counsel for the petitioners as well as learned counsel for respondent No.2 submit that the compromise has been arrived at between the parties.

This Court had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate for recording of statements. Pursuant thereto, now, there is a report from learned JMIC, Amloh stating that the statements have been recorded and the compromise is voluntary and is not the result of any pressure or coercion in any manner.

In that view of the matter, this petition is allowed. FIR No.105 dated 21.05.2016, under Sections 406, 498-A of IPC, registered at Police Station Gobindgarh Mandi, District Fatehgarh Sahib alongwith all consequential proceedings, is quashed by way of compounding/compromise.
