Petitioner seeks issuance of necessary directions to the official respondents in the context of protection of her right and personal liberty from being invaded at the hands of respondents No.4 to 10.

Pleadings made in sub-para 2(a) of para no.2 are sought to be supplemented by representations dated 20.03.2017 and 25.03.2017 filed before Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda and Human Right Commission, Punjab.

Learned counsel submitted that representation dated 20.03.2017 has necessary incorporation to the effect that the complaint before the SHO was not adhered to.

D.A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.
