This is a petition filed under Section 438 Cr. P.C. for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.35, dated 02.04.2017 under Sections 22/61/85 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Sadar Kotkapura, District Faridkot.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for further investigation.
