Petitioner seeks issuance of necessary directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to ensure liberty and security of the petitioner in view of threat perception at the hands of respondent No.4.

Petitioner has submitted that he was dealing with respondent No.4, as the respondent No.4 was a customer of his father. An amount of Rs.1,48,000/- was due towards respondent No.4 and the amount was not paid. In the meanwhile, respondent no.4 had purchased some electric goods from one Gurpreet Singh and made payments to him by way of cheque. Aforesaid Gurpreet Singh could not supply the goods to respondent no.4 and both of them were involved in some

dispute. Respondent no.4 remained under an impression that Gurpreet Singh is a close associate of the petitioner and with a view to implicate the petitioner, he started settling score with the petitioner by way of moving false complaints to respondent No.3. On refusal to invest in the business on the asking of respondent No.4, he started putting name of the petitioner in the complaint filed before the police.

Petitioner seeks fair inquiry/investigation in the complaint filed by respondent No.4 and also seeks protection of his civil rights and liberties.

Precisely, for the grievance in question, representation dated 04.04.2017 is pending before respondent no.3.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Rajiv Sharma, APP, UT, Chandigarh accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

At this stage, in view of nature of order which this Court proposes to pass, there is no necessity of filing any reply to the petition as no order prejudicial to interest of any of the party is being passed.

This petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the grievance of the petitioner in context of his representation dated 04.04.2017 and pass appropriate order in accordance with law.
