Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that at this stage he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Police District Khanna, (respondent no.2), to take an action in terms of the representation dated 09.05.2017 made by the petitioner, a copy of which has been annexed as Annexure P-2.

Though the said representation is only one week old, the petitioner is stated to be receiving threats from respondents no.4 to 7.

Consequently, without making any comment at all on the allegations made in this petition or in the representation, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent no.2, i.e. the Senior Superintendent of Police, Police District Khanna, to immediately look into the matter and take a decision as is warranted as per law, on the aforesaid representation, within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
