By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in FIR No.122 dated 10.04.2016, registered under Sections 406, 420 and 506 of Indian Penal Code at Police Station Shivaji Colony, Rohtak, District Rohtak.

On 25.05.2016, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Petitioner is alleged to have received a sum of Rs.30 lacs from complainant Promila Beniwal for admission of her son in ICARE Medical College, Haldia.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner being Director of ICARE Medical College, Haldia, had no occasion to contact the complainant demanding and receiving money for admission of her son against management quota-seat.

Counsel for the petitioner also submits that the complainant has not levelled any allegation against the petitioner rather has alleged that Dinesh Kumar, Munish Kumar and Vishal Bansal, nonapplicants had received the money from the complainant.

Notice to the Advocate General, Haryana, for 4.8.2016.

Meanwhile, an interim direction is issued that in case of arrest of the petitioner, he shall be

released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer subject to his joining investigation.”

It is contended that in pursuance of the order dated 25.05.2016, the petitioner has joined the investigation. The learned State counsel, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 25.05.2016, is made absolute, subject to furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

The petition stands allowed.
