This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C seeking the benefit of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.135 dated 13.9.2016 under section 386 I.P.C, registered at Police Station, Ateli, District Mahendergarh.

Learned counsel for the parties have been heard.

FIR came to be registered on the statement of Purshotam Dass Goyal. Allegations are that the present petitioner had earlier in point of time in the year 2012 come to the shop of the complainant and had fired a gun shot and which had led to the registration of an FIR. Precise allegations leading to the registration of the instant FIR are that repeated attempts were made to extort money and by placing telephonic calls on the mobile number of the complainant.

Petitioner was arrested on 15.9.2016.

It has gone uncontroverted that in the previous FIR registered in the year 2012 petitioner has earned acquittal.

The complainant is represented through Mr. Aditya Sanghi, Advocate and who does not rebut the contention raised by counsel appearing for the petitioner that a compromise between the parties has since been effected. Court has also been apprised that a quashing petition has been filed for setting aside the FIR in this Court and in which notice of motion has already been issued and statements in support of the compromise have been recorded before the Trial Court.

Without making any observations on merits and keeping in view the facts and circumstances noticed herein above, present petition is allowed. Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of C.J.M./Duty Magistrate, Mahendergarh.

Petition disposed of.
