The prayer in the instant petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.40 dated 25.06.2016, for the offence under Sections 354-B, 384, 341, 328, 201, 120-B 506 and Section 12 of POCSO Act and Section 66-E of IT Act, registered at Police Station Women Sonapat, District Sonipat.

Petitioner is in custody since 03.01.2017. Learned counsel for the State has informed the Court that victim appeared in Court and her examination of chief has been recorded. In her cross-examination, the complainant denied that petitioner never met her and never raised any demand of money or blackmailing her at any point of time.

Keeping in view the above and considering the fact that trial shall not mature in near future, petitioner be released on regular bail on furnishing his fresh bail bonds/sureties to the satisfaction of Duty Magistrate/Illaqa Magistrate, Sonapat.
