Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for
issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and
liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents i.e.
respondents No.4 to 11.

On 16.05.2017, this Court has passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that
despite repeated directions by District and Sessions
Judge, Patiala to protect the lives and liberty of
petitioners, respondent No.11 who is Incharge, Police
Post Century Enclave, Patiala is not caring for those
directions and has caused injuries to the petitioners.
This matter was again reported to the District and
Sessions Judge, Patiala, who gave further directions,
which are not being complied.

Notice to respondents No.1 and 2 for
01.06.2017.

Reply based on affidavit of respondent No.2 be
filed on the next date.”

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners states that he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the concerned Deputy Superintendent of Police to look into the grievance of the petitioners.

Ordered accordingly.

In case, the petitioners appears before the concerned Deputy Superintendent of Police and submits a written representation, the same shall be considered and dealt with in accordance with law.

With the aforesaid observations, present petition stands disposed of.
