The petitioners are seeking direction to respondents No.1 to 3 for protecting their life and liberty as they apprehend threat from respondents No.4 to 6.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the date of birth of the petitioner No.1 is 13.10.1997 while the date of birth of petitioner No.2 is 02.02.1991 and the copies of the Aadhaar cards in support thereof, are annexed as Annexures P-1 and P-2 respectively. Learned counsel for the petitioners also contends that there is an inadvertent error in paragraph No.2 of the petition regarding the dates of birth of the petitioners as the dates of birth of the petitioners have been interchanged. He has filed additional affidavits of both the petitioners in this regard in the course of hearing which are taken on record.

The petitioners are stated to have solemnized their marriage on 01.01.2017 and the photographs and the marriage certificate in this regard are annexed as Annexures P-3 and P-4 respectively. It is further stated in the petition that the petitioners had also made a representation dated 02.01.2017 (P-5) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Taran Taran but no action has so far

Issue notice to the respondents No.1 to 3.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. C.S. Brar, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

Without expressing any opinion on the validity of the marriage and keeping in view the mandate of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of **Lata Singh Vs. State of U.P and another, JT 2006 (6) SC 173**, the present petition is disposed of, with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Taran Taran-respondent No.2 to look into the matter and take appropriate action in accordance with law to ensure that no harm is caused to the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents.
