This order shall dispose of CRM-M-17519-2017, filed by
petitioner-Kulwant Singh and CRM-M-21762-2017, filed by petitioner-

Surinder Kaur, under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.78 dated 17.07.2016, registered at Police Station Ludhiana (Rural), District Ludhiana, under Sections 307, 326, 324, 427, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued in both these petitions. Learned State counsel has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested both these petitions.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that petitioner-Kulwant Singh is stated to be empty handed and no injury has been attributed to him whereas petitioner-Surinder Kaur is stated to be armed with *kirpan* and no injury has been attributed to her.

In pursuance of the interim orders dated 17.05.2017 passed in CRM-M-17519-2017 and 15.06.2017 passed in CRM-M-21762-2017 by this Court, the petitioners have already joined the investigation. They are not required for custodial interrogation. Therefore, no useful purpose will be served by sending the petitioners to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find merit in both these petitions and the same are allowed. The orders dated 17.05.2017 passed in CRM-M-17519-2017 and 15.06.2017 passed in CRM-M-21762-2017, granting interim bail to the petitioners, are made absolute. However, the
