Present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 805 dated 3.10.2013, under Sections 364A, 302, 201, 404 and 216/34 IPC, registered at Police Station City Jind.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that he be allowed to withdraw the present petition while restricting his prayer that the trial going on before the trial Court be concluded within a time limit.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Ranbir Singh contended that out of 34 witnesses, 27 prosecution witnesses including main witnesses, have been examined and only formal witnesses are remained to be examined.

In view of the above, the present petition for regular bail is dismissed. However, the trial Court is directed to complete the trial expeditiously and to make sincere efforts to conclude the same preferably within 4 months.
