By filing the present petition, under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioners have sought anticipatory bail in FIR No. 42 dated 01.09.2015, registered under Sections 420, 406, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of IPC and Sections 4 & 5 of the Prize Chit & Money Circulation Scheme (Banning) Act, 1978, at Police Station Sehna, District Barnala.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of the Court, Ms. Harsimrat Rai, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. A complete copy of the paper book has been furnished to the learned State counsel, in the Court.

Heard.

It is contended that the parties have entered into compromise, vide Annexure P-4. The similarly placed co-accused, namely, R.K. Vats has been admitted to bail by the trial Court, whereas, other co-accused have been acquitted of the charges. However, the fact that the petitioners

have successfully evaded the process of the Court cannot be ignored.

Considering the fact that co-accused has been admitted to bail and other co-accused have been acquitted, it is ordered that in case the petitioners surrender before the competent Court within one week from today and file regular bail application, the same shall be considered and decided expeditiously.
