By this order I shall dispose of two petitions so moved by the
petitioners being co-accused in FIR No.13 dated 27.04.2017 under Sections
420, 468, 471, 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Airport Amritsar,
District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioners state that petitioner-Vishal Duggal @ Kali Duggal and petitioner-Paramjit Singh have since joined the investigation in compliance of order dated 17.05.2017 passed in **CRM-M-17548-2017** & order dated 20.06.2017 passed in **CRM-M-22301-2017** and they are ready to surrender their passports with the Investigating Officer.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Bhupinder Singh, Police Station Airport, Amritsar concedes the above fact and further submitted that their custodial interrogations are not required since no recovery is to be effected from them.

It being so, interim order dated 17.05.2017 passed in **CRM-M-17548-2017** & interim order dated 20.06.2017 passed in **CRM-M-22301-2017** are made absolute subject to fulfilment of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.. However, the petitioners are directed to surrender their passports before the Investigating Officer within a week from today.

The petitions are allowed accordingly.
