The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C seeking quashing of FIR No.523 dated 12.8.2016 under sections 379-A, 341, 323, 427, 506, 201, 34 I.P.C, registered at Police Station, Sadar Palwal, District Palwal.

Counsel would submit that the matter has since been compromised with the complainant namely Balesh wife of Sukki/respondent no.2.

Perusal of the impugned FIR would reveal that there are allegations of chain snatching as also earrings of the complainant.

On a specific query having been put to the counsel it stands conceded that the petitioners are habitual offenders and are involved in three other FIRs on similar allegations.

Confronted with a situation where this Court was not inclined to entertain a quashing petition on the basis of a compromise at the hands of habitual offenders, counsel prays for withdrawal of the present petition.

Prayer is allowed.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

It is, however, clarified that disposal of the present petition as withdrawn will not preclude the petitioners from raising all pleas in their defence as may be available in accordance with law.

Disposed of.
