Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that despite the FIR in question having been registered on 29.06.2016, no action thereafter, has been taken by the police (as alleged).

He further submits that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the Director General of Police, Haryana, to go into the grievance of the petitioner in terms of the representation made to him on 27.02.2017, a copy of which has been annexed with the petition as Annexure P-2, and to take a decision thereon within a specified period.

Consequently, without going into the merits of the contentions made in the petition, in any manner whatsoever, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the Director General of Police, Haryana, to go into the matter and to take a decision as per law, on the representation of the petitioner, within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
