Heard learned Counsel for the rival parties.

The petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in FIR No.57 dated 19.4.2017, under Sections 420, 120-B IPC and Sections 8 and 9 of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988, registered at Police Station Bhawanigarh, District Sangrur. Seen the reply filed by the State of Punjab. This Court had asked the Learned Counsel for the State to find out the status of other cases. It appears that there are four cases registered against the petitioner. However, Learned Counsel for the petitioner has pointed out judgment of acquittal in case FIR No.187. Recovery of Rs.5,000/- has been made according to the prosecution. Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that from the co-accused recovery has been made and allegedly paid to him. Be that as it may, the petitioner is released on anticipatory bail subject to furnishing undertaking not to commit any such offence in future. He shall report to the concerned Police Station on every Monday, Wednesday and Sunday between 11 AM to 4 PM.
