In response to the order dated 24.05.2017, learned Counsel for the State, on instructions from the police official who is present in Court today to assist him, submits that though nobody was deputed to the native village of the parents of petitioner no. 1 in District Bijour, Uttar Pradesh, however, as per the parents of petitioner no. 1, who are stated to be now working in Jalandhar, the first petitioner is only 15 years of age.

Though this Court finds it strange that despite the order directing the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, to have the matter enquired into from Bijour, that has not been done, however, this petition is presently disposed of with a direction that all proceedings as per law would continue, provided it is verified from the native district of the parents of petitioner No.1 that her age is

indeed below 18 years.
