Through the present petition, quashing of FIR No.334, dated 21.11.2012, under Sections 307/34 IPC and 24/ 54/ 59 of Arms Act, registered at Police City Sangrur, District Sangrur is sought for on the basis of compromise(Annexure P-2).

Through, order of this Court dated 03.08.2016, the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court to get their statements recorded, who, in turn, was directed to send a report to this Court as also to apprise this Court if any of them has been declared proclaimed offender.

As directed, report dated 18.08.2016 from the Additional District & Sessions Judge, Sangrur has been received, according to which, the parties recorded their statements before the trial Court in terms of the compromise arrived at between them and none of the accused is proclaimed offender.

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Learned State counsel has also not raised any objection.

In view of the above, the prayer in the instant petition for quashing of FIR No.334, dated 21.11.2012, under Sections 307/34 IPC and 25/ 54/ 59 of Arms Act, registered at Police City Sangrur, District Sangrur is accepted and the FIR (Exhibit P-1) is accordingly quashed, and consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
