The petitioner has challenged the order dated 20.01.2017 passed by the Additional Sessions Judge, Amritsar whereby he has been declared as Proclaimed Offender in FIR No.235 dated 11.06.2015, under Sections 21/22/61/85 NDPS Act and 379/411 IPC, registered at Police Station A Division, Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner was an inmate of Drug Counselling and Rehabilitation Centre from 17.11.2016 to 16.02.2017. Therefore, the impugned order is not sustainable in law. Learned counsel further contends that in terms of the interim order of a coordinate Bench of this Court passed on 25.05.2017 in CrI.Misc.No.M-16637 of 2017, the petitioner has appeared before the trial Court and has been granted interim bail.

Therefore, as the petitioner has appeared before the trial Court in terms of the interim order of this Court, this petition has been rendered infructuous and stands disposed of accordingly.
