Through the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr. P. C., the petitioner seeks the concession of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 502, dated 10.11.2016, registered under Sections 147, 148, 149, 323, 506, 332, 333, 353, 186 and 427 IPC, at Police Station City, Bhiwani.

Vide order dated 20.01.2017, while issuing notice of motion, this Court had granted the concession of ad-interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner to the satisfaction of the arresting officer.
