Report of the Mediator has been received. The matter has been amicably settled by the parties. I have also made inquiries from the petitioner as well as parents of petitioner No.1 who say that they are satisfied with the settlement agreement which is taken on record as C-1.

Counsel for the petitioner and private respondents submits that the matter may be disposed of as per the settlement. The private respondents also undertake that they will not interfere in the life and liberty of the petitioners in any manner and if at any point of time, the petitioners deem it appropriate, they can visit the house of the private respondents and other relatives and their liberty and security will be duly secured.

Taking note of the above facts, this petition is disposed of with direction to SSP, Tarn Taran to take immediate action relating to security and liberty of the petitioners. If eventuality so arise at any point of time in future, the petitioners will move the application before the police which will be taken care.

However, it is made clear that this order will have no effect on the validity of alleged marriage of the petitioners or on any other civil or criminal proceedings instituted against them.
