FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Surinder Singh in case registered by way of FIR No.108 dated 13.04.2016 at Police Station City Khanna, District Ludhiana under Sections 409/420/465/467/468/471 IPC.

In the light of contentions that the petitioner has made compliance of the orders dated 18.05.2017 whereby he has deposited Rs.50,000/- in the Court which could not be refuted by learned counsel for the complainant Mr.Rahul Vats, Advocate who submits that the complainant is likely to withdraw the said amount, and therefore, in the light of this bona fide shown by the petitioner and the fact that nothing is

to be recovered from the petitioner and culpability, if any, shall be determined at the trial, impels this Court to allow the prayer made.

Accordingly, the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 23.09.2016 is made absolute on the same terms and conditions till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions specified under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. and thereafter, he will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
