Learned State counsel has placed on record detailed report along with supporting documents.

In the light of the report submitted by the Police duly signed by the concerned Station House Officer based on the statements of the respectables of the village supported by invitation card, the customs and ceremonies of Ranjot Singh Virk, son of the petitioner Sukhjit Singh @ Sukha are to be solemnised on 21.5.2017. Keeping in view the religious customs and that the presence of the petitioner being a father of the male child whose ceremonies are to be performed is essential at the time of these ceremonies and, thus, taking a lenient view, in the interest of justice the prayer is allowed. Petitioner is granted interim bail for a period of two days with effect from 20.05.2017 to 21.05.2017 subject to furnishing of personal bonds for an amount of Rs.10,00,000/- with two sureties in the like amount to the satisfaction of Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Sangrur and the

petitioner shall surrender before the Jail authorities on 22.05.2017 at 10.00 a.m.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
